Welcome to the information page for the MASTMO Master of Science Programme!

MASTMO (MAthematical and STatistical Modelling) is a MSc programme at the Department of Mathematical and Physical Sciences, <u>Hawassa University</u>, Hawassa, Ethiopia.

The 1<sup>st</sup> cohort of 19 students started in September 2010 and graduated in the summer of 2012. A list of student names along with titles of their master theses are found here: MASTMO first cohort.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> cohort of students, starting September 2011, graduated in the summer of 2013: MASTMO students 2nd Cohort.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> cohort containing 10 students started in October 2013: MASTMO students 3rd Cohort.

MASTMO is a MSc programme focussing on applications of mathematics and statistics. Modern techniques and extensive use of computers are integrated parts of the programme. to one of three application areas of special interest to Ethiopia:

- Agriculture and Plant Science
- Health Science
- Environmental and Earth Sciences (this option will be added later)

After completing the programme, you will have competence in methods that are useful and asked for in many different fields. And the best of all, you acquire knowledge and methodologies having permanent values, and you are trained in acquiring new knowledge for the rest of your life!

MASTMO has been developed in collaboration with the Industrial Mathematics programme at the Department of Mathematical Sciences, Norwegian University of Science and Technology, Trondheim, Norway. The NTNU programme has been running since 1982, as a part of European Consortium for Mathematics in Industry (ECMI).

You are a candidate for the MASTMO MSc programme if you

- have a BSc in Mathematics, Statistics, or related fields,
- feel you have a potential for numerical and analytical skills,
- wish to apply mathematical and statistical methods to practical problems,
- would like to get an education which opens doors to many different jobs.
